Achievement of Home Department 2021-2022

1. General:

a. Police:

- Mobile patrolling by all the LEA's are being carried out especially by eagle Squad.
- Multiple Fixed Check points at all the entry and exit points as well as random check posts have been established.
- For the safe journey the Security of Highways has been enhanced and movement of buses in Convoys through some parts of Balochistan being carried out.
- Effective measures have been taken for the proper security of Prisoners in the Province.
- Proper Security arrangements have been made for the safe passage of Zaireen from Quetta to Taftan and back.
- Special security measures have been made for securing the event of Muharram, Eid and National Days.
- Special measures have been taken to restrict the illegal immigrants in camps and their repatriation.
- To streamline the intelligence mechanism in the Province, provincial, divisional and district level Apex Committees have been constituted. So far 11 Provincial Apex Committee meetings have been conducted last dated 12th March, 2019.
- Securing about 2430 Kms long porous border with Afghanistan and Iran the fencing along Pak-Afghan Border has been completed and the fencing along Pak-Iran border is underway.
- Establishment of Eagle Squad.
- Establishment of Counter Terrorism Command (CTC).
- Revamping of CTD.
- Raising of Anti Terrorism Force (Police/Levies).
- Updating Red Books & Persons on 4th Schedule.
- Capacity Building of Police & Levies through training by ATF School & Army.
- Quick Response — 05 QRF, Falcon M/Cycle Squads & 15 Emergency Centers

b. Levies:

- In 13 districts Levies recruitment has been completed (1340 recruited).
- Locator purchased, staff trained — operation continued.
- Construction of Levies directorate.
- RTC — fully functional with basic, advanced and elite training.
- Col (R) M. Anwar has been appointed for Commandant Training.
- In Levies a specialized Cadre established with better prospect of Command structure.

- The recruitment of socio economic unit in Levies is underway Establishment of levies bomb disposal squad (285 personnel trained)..
- Technological interventions (Geo Fencing & Locators).
- Raising of counter terrorism wing in Levies.
- Establishment of QRF in Levies.
- Establishment of newly intelligence wing, Investigation wing and communication and IT wing in levies.
- Establishment of Special Socio-Economic protection Unit (1385 posts created).
- Establishment CPEC wing (1561 posts created)
- Establishment of Data and Resource Centre
- Strengthening& upgradation of levies training center (LTC)

c. Prison Department:

- Training of prison staff from abroad.
- Revamping of vocational training of prisons.
- Formulation of parole committee.
- Promotion of staff.
- Up-gradation, renovation & repair of existing infrastructural conditions.
- Establishment of rehabilitation Centers for drug addicts in Central Prison Mach, Gaddani & District Prison Quetta.
- Development / up-gradation of the existing water resources to reduce the scarcity of this basic human need.
- Establishment of modern Mini Pathological Labs.
- Provision of X-Ray Plants, ECG & Ultrasound Machines.
- Construction of additional bathrooms and toilets in the Prisons.
- Enhanced deployment of LEAS (Police, FC, Levies) for external Security of the Prisons.
- Provision and installation of electronic security gadgetry: CCTV, X-Ray Baggage Machine, Wireless System, Surveillance drones, Metal / Explosive / Drug detectors.
- Facilitation of uninterrupted power supply: solar system / heavy duty generators.
- Establishment of computer literacy center at all Central Prisons. Provision of 60 computers along with related gadgetry.
- Establishment of a High School at all the District Jails and a Higher Secondary School at all the Central Jails. Education Department / B-TEVTA.
- Establishment of technical education in the VTCs under construction.
- Establishment of libraries in Prisons.
- Establishment of Provincial Prisons Training Institute (PPTI).

D Civil Defence Department:

- Establishment of Bomb Disposal squad led by Deputy Director (Technical) in all divisions.
- Diffusion of 67 IEd's/Hand Grenades.
- Demolishing of 45000 Kg explosive material at Quetta.
- Demolishing of 12700 Kg explosive material at Sibi.
- Forwarding of 847 expert opinions/reports police authorities in different cases. Trainings imparted in different colleges/schools both boys & girls and different Departments & Private Organizations.
- Establishment of CDB offices at District level .
- Establishment of CDB rescue department at Divisional Level.

e. Reclamation and Probation Department:

- **Formulation of Data base of all those prisoners/offenders eligible to be released on parole/probation.**
- **Convening of regular parole committee meetings.**
- **The Directorate has been in communion with NADRA for issuance of CNIC to all such prisoners having no CNIC but eligible for release on parole/Probation.**
- **Concept papers have been prepared for the establishment of Divisional Offices.**
- **Regular meetings with Provincial Ombudsmen and Criminal Justice Coordination Committee etc.**
- **Establishment of R&P office at District Level.**
- **Capacity building of Parole & Probation officers.**
- **Framing of rules of Boarstal institution Act, 2014 with collaboration of UNODC under Rule of Law Project.**
- **The stablemen of Adult Reclamation center.**
- **Reframing of service rules.**
- **Revisiting supervision mechanism in the light of evidence based practices.**
- **Proper monitoring of parolees/probationers after the completion of supervision period.**

2. Legal:

- **Reforms in Anti Terrorist Courts and protection of Judges, lawyers and investigators as well as amendments in Laws — especially Law of evidence have been made.**
- **Draft proposals for improvement in criminal justice system have been submitted to Ministry of Law.**
- **To avoid retractions, fool proof mechanism for protection of witness is made.**
- **Reformed version of FCR is being introduced in the border districts of Balochistan for eventual implementation of Law of the land.**
- **Evidence Act is being amended.**
- **Following 05 Laws have been amended by the Provincial Government:-**
 - i. **The Balochistan Hotels Restrictions (Security) Act 2015 (August 2015) Act No. IX 5.**
 - ii. **The Balochistan Restrictions of Rented Buildings (Security) Act 2015 August, 2015). Act No. X of 2015.**
 - iii. **The Balochistan Sound Systems (Regulation) Bill 2015.**
 - iv. **The Balochistan Prohibition of Expressing Matters on Walls (Amendment) Bill, 2015.**
 - v. **The Balochistan Witness Protection Bill, 2015.**

3. Political:

- **Political main streaming is being carried out.**
- **Meaningful dialogue process with the influential political leadership and political mainstream is under way.**
- **To ascertain the progress on TORS of the National Action Plan point No.17 on Political**
- **Reconciliation. First meeting of the Expert group was held on 28th August, 2019 under the chairmanship of Honorable CM Baluchistan. Matter is in active consideration of the Provincial Government.**
- **Efforts are being made for the safe recovery of missing persons.**

4. **Economic:**

- Economic activities have been boosted up with special emphasis on Gawadar Port, Kachhi Canal, water and mineral projects.
- Higher Education, Technical and vocational training facilities have been created.
- Employment opportunities in the public and private sector have been created.
- Special development packages have been prepared in Balochistan.

5. **China-Pakistan Economic Corridor (CPEC):**

- The China-Pakistan Economic Corridor is one of the game changers and would bring prosperity in the region. This would not only boost up the economic trade but also bring prosperity for a common man. Besides, the intelligence agencies of neighboring countries i.e. Raw and NDS are creating troubles to keep disturbed the Economic Corridor and committing terrorist activities especially in Balochistan.

6. **Gawadar Safe City Project:**

- For the safety and security of Gawadar, Government of Balochistan has initiated a project namely "Gawadar Safe City Project" wherein networking/installation of CCTV cameras, Laser fencing, Raising of Police Force, deployment of armed forces is underway. Likewise, the same project has also been started for the safety and security of Quetta City which is in completion phase.
